6 Remove lines 1900-1930 and insert:

7 department shall adopt a methodology for calculating each
8 private prekindergarten provider's and public school provider's
9 performance metric. The methodology must include a statistical
10 latent profile analysis used to produce the assignment of a
11 letter grading system to include grades "A" through "F". Each
12 provider's performance metric or grade must be based on a
13 combination of the following:

14 1. Program assessment composite scores under subsection
15 (2), which must be weighted at no less than 50 percent.

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16 2. Learning gains operationalized as change in ability
17 scores from the initial and final progress monitoring results
18 described in subsection (1).

19 3. Norm-referenced developmental learning outcomes
20 described in subsection (1).

21 (b) The methodology for calculating a provider's
22 performance metric may only include prekindergarten students who
23 have attended at least 85 percent of a private prekindergarten
24 provider's or public school provider's program.

25 (c) The program assessment composite score, performance
26 metric, and grade must be calculated by private prekindergarten
27 or public school site.

28 (d) Subject to an appropriation, the department must
29 provide for a differential payment
