A bill to be entitled

An act relating to a special election; providing for a special election to be held on August 18, 2020, pursuant to Section 5, Article XI of the State Constitution, for the approval or rejection by the electors of this state of amendments to the State Constitution, proposed by joint resolution, relating to an ad valorem tax discount for spouses of certain deceased veterans who had permanent, combat-related disabilities, the transfer of the ad valorem tax discount to another permanent residence of the surviving spouse under specified conditions, and an effective date if such amendments are adopted; providing for publication of notice and election procedures; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 5, Article XI of the State Constitution, there shall be a special election on August 18, 2020, to be held concurrently with other statewide elections held on that date, if any, at which there shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection the amendments to the State Constitution proposed in Senate Joint Resolution 1076, 2020 Regular Session, or a similar joint resolution having substantially the same specific intent and purpose.

Section 2. <u>Publication of notice shall be in accordance</u> with Section 5, Article XI of the State Constitution. The

special election shall be held in the same manner in which other special elections are held.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, if enacted by a vote of at least three-fourths of the membership of each house of the Legislature and if Senate Joint Resolution 1076, 2020 Regular Session, or a similar joint resolution having substantially the same specific intent and purpose, is adopted by both houses of the Legislature.
