7 (100) DIVINE NINE LICENSE PLATES.—

8 (a) The department shall develop a Divine Nine license
9 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053 for each of
10 the organizations listed in sub-subparagraphs 2.a.-i. The plate
11 must bear the colors and design approved by the department, and
12 must include the official logo as appropriate for each
13 organization. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
14 plate, and the word "Divine" must appear at the bottom of the
15 plate.

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16 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
17 be distributed as follows:

18 1. Five percent of the proceeds shall be distributed to
19 the United Negro College Fund, Inc., for college scholarships
20 for Florida residents attending Florida's historically black
21 colleges and universities.

22 2. The remaining 95 percent of the proceeds shall be
23 distributed to one of the following organizations as selected by
24 the purchaser of the plate who shall receive a license plate
25 with the design associated with the appropriate recipient
26 organization:

27 a. Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.

28 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the
29 Florida Federation of Alpha Chapters, Inc., to promote community
30 awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural
31 service activities within this state.

32 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the Florida
33 Federation of Alpha Chapters, Inc., solely for the marketing of
34 the plate.

35 b. Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.

36 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the Alpha
37 Kappa Alpha Educational Advancement Foundation, Inc., to promote
38 community awareness and action through educational, economic,
39 and cultural service activities within this state.

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40 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the Alpha Kappa
41 Alpha Educational Advancement Foundation, Inc., solely for the
42 marketing of the plate.

43 c. Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.

44 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the
45 Southern Province of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., to
46 promote community awareness and action through educational,
47 economic, and cultural service activities within this state.

48 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the Southern
49 Province of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., solely for the
50 marketing of the plate.

51 d. Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.

52 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the State
53 of Florida Omega Friendship Foundation, Inc., to promote
54 community awareness and action through educational, economic,
55 and cultural service activities within this state.

56 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the State of
57 Florida Omega Friendship Foundation, Inc., solely for the
58 marketing of the plate.

59 e. Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

60 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the Delta
61 Research and Educational Foundation, Inc., to promote community
62 awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural
63 service activities within this state.

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64 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the Delta
65 Research and Educational Foundation, Inc., solely for the
66 marketing of the plate.

67 f. Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.

68 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the TMB
69 Charitable Foundation, Inc., to promote community awareness and
70 action through educational, economic, and cultural service
71 activities within this state.

72 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the TMB
73 Charitable Foundation, Inc., solely for the marketing of the
74 plate.

75 g. Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.

76 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the
77 Florida Pearls, Inc., to promote community awareness and action
78 through educational, economic, and cultural service activities
79 within this state.

80 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the Florida
81 Pearls, Inc., solely for the marketing of the plate.

82 h. Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc.

83 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the Sigma
84 Gamma Rho Sorority National Education Fund, Inc., to promote
85 community awareness and action through educational, economic,
86 and cultural service activities within this state.

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87 (II) Ten percent shall be distributed to the Sigma Gamma
88 Rho Sorority National Education Fund, Inc., solely for the
89 marketing of the plate.

90 i. Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc.

91 (I) Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the
92 National Iota Foundation, Inc., to promote community awareness
93 and action through educational, economic, and cultural service
94 activities within this state.
