6 Remove lines 68-73 and insert:

7 in this state. The agency may grant no more than three
 8 exemptions under this paragraph.

9 1. The exemption under this paragraph does not require a
 10 specific legislative appropriation.

11 2. An exemption under this paragraph shall terminate 18
 12 months after the date of issuance unless the exemption holder
 13 has commenced construction. The agency shall monitor the
 14 progress of the holder of the certificate of exemption in
 15 meeting the timetable for project development specified in the
 16 application for exemption. The agency shall extend the time

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17 period for a project, if the exemption holder demonstrates to
18 the satisfaction of the agency that good-faith commencement of
19 the project is being delayed by litigation or by governmental
20 action or inaction with respect to regulations or permitting
21 precluding commencement of the project.

22 3. This paragraph and subsection (6) of s. 400.962 are
23 repealed July 1, 2022, unless reviewed and saved from repeal by
24 the Legislature.
