Such leave of absence may 44 be granted upon the request of the employee American Red Cross 45 and upon the approval of the employee's employing agency after 46 verifying the employee's volunteer status. An employee granted leave under this section is shall not be deemed to be an 47 48 employee of the state for purposes of workers' compensation. Leave under this section act may be granted only for providing 49 50 volunteer for services related to a disaster occurring within
