16	Trade and Investment Working Group has been laying the
17	groundwork to strengthen trade and investment ties for the
18	present and in the future, including through the use of a free
19	trade agreement, and
20	WHEREAS, expansion of global trade, especially with the
21	United Kingdom, is of vital importance to the growth of the
22	United States' economy, small business participation in the
23	international marketplace, and job creation, and
24	WHEREAS, this state would benefit greatly from the
25	ratification of a comprehensive free trade agreement, which,

since the United Kingdom is currently the largest foreign direct employer in this state and is the second largest market for tourism, would create employment opportunities for residents of this state as a direct result of removing and reducing barriers to trade and free markets, and

31 WHEREAS, the successful implementation of a free trade 32 agreement will increase exports to the United Kingdom from this 33 state, and

34 WHEREAS, the United States Constitution grants the United 35 States Congress exclusive authority to regulate commerce with 36 foreign nations, and

37 WHEREAS, the negotiation of a successful free trade 38 agreement between the United States and the United Kingdom will 39 require bipartisan cooperation between state, federal, and 40 foreign governments, NOW, THEREFORE,
