**Amendment**

Remove lines 41-55 and insert:

(b) Identify all criteria developed pursuant to paragraph (a) by July 1, 2020. Before the issuance of a competitive procurement for the evaluation and report required by subsection (1), the criteria identified pursuant to this paragraph and the estimated cost of the procurement shall be subject to the notice, review, and objection provisions of s. 216.177, Florida Statutes.

(c) Evaluate the bid responses and select an entity to conduct the program evaluations.

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14       (3) The program evaluations must include a history of the  
15 program; a description of the program, including its objectives,  
16 methods of assistance; a review of the eligibility criteria for  
17 the program; the process used to establish and document  
18 eligibility; the frequency of eligibility determinations; the  
19 clarity in written, verbal, and electronic communication in  
20 which eligibility requirements are conveyed to current and  
21 potential program subscribers; the opportunities for improving  
22 service efficiency and efficacy across programs; and the number  
23 of families, including family size and identification and  
24 analysis of single parent versus two parent households receiving  
25 multiple program services out of total eligible families. In  
26 addition, to the degree possible for each program, the program  
27 evaluation must quantify the changes in levels of economic self-  
28 sufficiency among Floridians over the last 3 program years;

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
