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Delete lines 392 - 406

4 and insert:

access or curb cut allowing vehicular access to the property, within 10 $\frac{5}{2}$ feet from the road as defined in s. 334.03(22) public right-of-way line. If there are no curbs or access barriers, the signs must be posted not fewer less than one sign for each 25 feet of lot frontage.

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b. The notice must clearly indicate, in not fewer less than



2-inch high, light-reflective letters on a contrasting background, that unauthorized vehicles will be towed away at the owner's expense. The words "tow-away zone" must be included on the sign in not fewer less than 4-inch high letters.

- c. The notice must also provide the name and current telephone number of the person or firm towing or removing the vehicles or vessels.
- d. The sign structure containing the required notices must be permanently installed with the words "tow-away zone" not less than 3 feet and not more than 6 feet above ground level and must
