 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
 8

9 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section
 10 338.155, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

11 338.155 Payment of toll on toll facilities required;
 12 exemptions.—

13 (1)(a) A person may not use a toll facility without
 14 payment of tolls, except:

15 1. An employee of the agency operating the toll project
 16 when using the toll facility on official state business.

17 2. A person engaged in active military service as defined
 18 ~~in s. 115.08 State military personnel while on official military~~
 19 ~~business.~~

20 3. A person with a disability as provided in subsection
 21 (3).

22 4. A person exempt from toll payment by the authorizing
 23 resolution for bonds issued to finance the facility.

24 5. A person exempt on a temporary basis where use of such
 25 toll facility is required as a detour route.

26 | 6. A law enforcement officer operating an official vehicle
27 | while on official law enforcement business.

28 | 7. A person operating a fire vehicle while on official
29 | business or a rescue vehicle while on official business.

30 | 8. A person participating in the funeral procession of a
31 | law enforcement officer or firefighter killed in the line of
32 | duty.

33 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
