 2 An act relating to prohibited places for weapons and
 3 firearms; amending s. 790.06, F.S.; authorizing an
 4 elected member of a specified governing body who holds
 5 a license to carry a handgun or a concealed weapon or
 6 firearm to carry a concealed weapon or firearm to a
 7 meeting of the governing body of which he or she is a
 8 member; providing an effective date.

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 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 12 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (12) of section
 13 790.06, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

14 790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

15 (12) (a) A license issued under this section does not
 16 authorize any person to openly carry a handgun or carry a
 17 concealed weapon or firearm into:

- 18 1. Any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05;
- 19 2. Any police, sheriff, or highway patrol station;
- 20 3. Any detention facility, prison, or jail;
- 21 4. Any courthouse;
- 22 5. Any courtroom, except that nothing in this section
 23 would preclude a judge from carrying a concealed weapon or
 24 determining who will carry a concealed weapon in his or her
 25 courtroom;

- 26 6. Any polling place;
- 27 7. Any meeting of the governing body of a county, public
- 28 school district, municipality, or special district, except that
- 29 nothing in this section would preclude an elected member of the
- 30 governing body of a county, public school district,
- 31 municipality, or special district from carrying a concealed
- 32 weapon or firearm to a meeting of the governing body of which he
- 33 or she is a member;
- 34 8. Any meeting of the Legislature or a committee thereof;
- 35 9. Any school, college, or professional athletic event not
- 36 related to firearms;
- 37 10. Any elementary or secondary school facility or
- 38 administration building;
- 39 11. Any career center;
- 40 12. Any portion of an establishment licensed to dispense
- 41 alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, which
- 42 portion of the establishment is primarily devoted to such
- 43 purpose;
- 44 13. Any college or university facility unless the licensee
- 45 is a registered student, employee, or faculty member of such
- 46 college or university and the weapon is a stun gun or nonlethal
- 47 electric weapon or device designed solely for defensive purposes
- 48 and the weapon does not fire a dart or projectile;
- 49 14. The inside of the passenger terminal and sterile area
- 50 of any airport, provided that no person shall be prohibited from

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51 carrying any legal firearm into the terminal, which firearm is
52 encased for shipment for purposes of checking such firearm as
53 baggage to be lawfully transported on any aircraft; or

54 15. Any place where the carrying of firearms is prohibited
55 by federal law.

56 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
