7 Section 2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section
8 1006.07, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (d), and
9 paragraph (c) is added to that subsection, to read:

10 1006.07 District school board duties relating to student
11 discipline and school safety.—The district school board shall
12 provide for the proper accounting for all students, for the
13 attendance and control of students at school, and for proper
14 attention to health, safety, and other matters relating to the
15 welfare of students, including:

17 (c) Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, each public
18 elementary, middle, and high school campus, including charter
19 schools, must be equipped with a panic alarm for use in a life-
20 threatening emergency, including active shooter and hostage
21 situations. The panic alarm must immediately transmit a signal
22 or message upon activation of a device to report a life-
23 threatening emergency situation to a public safety answering
24 point, as defined in s. 365.172, to deploy appropriate first
25 responders to the school. School employees must be able to
26 activate the panic alarm from any building or other location on
27 the campus.
