6 Remove lines 23-32 and insert:

7 schools, must implement a mobile panic button system with
8 interoperability capability to connect diverse emergency
9 services technologies to ensure the real-time coordination
10 between multiple first responders. Such a system, which shall
11 be referred to as Alyssa's Alert, shall integrate with local
12 public safety answering point infrastructure to transmit
13 emergency 9-1-1 calls and mobile device application activations.

14 Section 3. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the sum of \$8
15 million in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund is
16 appropriated to the Department of Education to implement the

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17 mobile panic button system required by s. 1006.07(4)(c), Florida
18 Statutes. The department shall issue a competitive solicitation
19 to contract for a statewide mobile panic button system that can
20 be utilized by all school districts at no cost to the school
21 district. The department shall consult with the school safety
22 specialists established pursuant to s. 1006.07(6), Florida
23 Statutes, in the development of the competitive solicitation for
24 the statewide mobile panic button system.

25 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
