**Substitute Amendment for Amendment (938611) (with title amendment)**

Between lines 281 and 282, insert:

Section 3. Paragraph (n) of subsection (2) of section 1003.42, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1003.42 Required instruction.—

(2) Members of the instructional staff of the public schools, subject to the rules of the State Board of Education and the district school board, shall teach efficiently and faithfully, using the books and materials required that meet the highest standards for professionalism and historical accuracy,

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14 following the prescribed courses of study, and employing  
15 approved methods of instruction, the following:

16 (n) Comprehensive health education that addresses concepts  
17 of community health; consumer health; environmental health;  
18 family life, including an awareness of the benefits of sexual  
19 abstinence as the expected standard and the consequences of  
20 ~~teenage~~ pregnancy; the full range of contraceptive methods  
21 available to prevent pregnancy; mental and emotional health;  
22 injury prevention and safety; Internet safety; nutrition;  
23 personal health; prevention and control of disease; and  
24 substance use and abuse. The health education curriculum for  
25 students in grades 7 through 12 shall include a teen dating  
26 violence and abuse component that includes, but is not limited  
27 to, the definition of dating violence and abuse, the warning  
28 signs of dating violence and abusive behavior, the  
29 characteristics of healthy relationships, measures to prevent  
30 and stop dating violence and abuse, and community resources  
31 available to victims of dating violence and abuse. The  
32 Department of Health, in consultation with the department, shall  
33 develop instructional materials regarding the full range of  
34 contraceptive methods available to prevent pregnancy, including  
35 the efficacy of each method, which must be in easily  
36 comprehensible language and include only medically accurate,  
37 evidence-based information. School districts shall include the  
38 instructional materials in their health education curriculum.

40 The State Board of Education is encouraged to adopt standards  
41 and pursue assessment of the requirements of this subsection. A  
42 character development program that incorporates the values of  
43 the recipients of the Congressional Medal of Honor and that is  
44 offered as part of a social studies, English Language Arts, or  
45 other schoolwide character building and veteran awareness  
46 initiative meets the requirements of paragraphs (s) and (t).

56 pregnancy of a minor unless specified requirements are  
57 satisfied; requiring a physician to obtain written  
58 consent from a minor's parent or legal guardian before  
59 performing or inducing a termination of the pregnancy  
60 of a minor; requiring the consenting parent or legal  
61 guardian to provide specified proof of identification
