(b)1. Court proceedings under this section ~~subsection~~ must be given precedence over other pending matters to the extent necessary to ensure that the court reaches a decision promptly. The court shall rule, and issue written findings of fact and conclusions of law, within 2 calendar ~~3 business~~ days after the petition is filed, except that the 2-calendar-day ~~3-business-day~~ limitation may be extended at the request of the minor. If the court fails to rule within the 2-calendar-day ~~3-business-day~~
