11	Section 1. Present subsection (6) of section 828.12,
12	Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (7), and a new
13	subsection (6) is added to that section, to read:
14	828.12 Cruelty to animals
15	(6) If the temperature is below $32^{\circ}F$ or the National
16	Weather Service has issued a severe weather advisory or warning
17	and a person leaves a dog outside and unattended, regardless of
18	whether the dog has access to an outdoor shelter, the person
19	commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as
20	provided in s. 775.082 or by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or
21	both. For purposes of this subsection:
22	(a) A dog is considered to have been left outside and
23	unattended if it is left in a securely fenced yard or a kennel
24	or is tethered by use of a restraint.
25	(b) The term "restraint" means a chain, a rope, a tether, a
26	leash, a cable, or another device that attaches a dog to a
27	stationary object or trolley system.
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
