

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to the Tri-Par Estates Park and
 3 Recreation District, Sarasota County; amending ch.
 4 2001-343, Laws of Florida; authorizing the board of
 5 trustees to adopt and enforce certain rules and
 6 regulations governing the use of district facilities
 7 and prescribe penalties for violations of such rules
 8 and regulations; providing an effective date.

 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 12 Section 1. Paragraphs (g) and (h) of section 15 and
 13 section 17 of section 3 of chapter 2001-343, Laws of Florida,
 14 are amended to read:

15 Section 15. The trustees shall supervise all real and
 16 personal property owned by the district, and shall have the
 17 following powers in addition to those already herein enumerated:

18 (g) To adopt and enforce ~~promulgate~~ reasonable rules and
 19 regulations governing the use of the facilities of the district
 20 as provided in chapter 418, Florida Statutes, and to prescribe
 21 penalties for violations of such rules and regulations.

22 (h) To use district funds in the administration and
 23 enforcement of the deed restrictions as filed in the Sarasota
 24 County public records for properties within the district, and to
 25 prescribe such penalties or exercise such enforcement remedies

26 | as may be provided for in the deed restrictions.

27 | Section 17. A record shall be kept of all meetings of the
28 | board of trustees and in such meetings a concurrence of a
29 | majority of said trustees shall be necessary to any affirmative
30 | action taken by the board. Said trustees may adopt such rules,
31 | ~~and~~ regulations, and penalties, not inconsistent with any
32 | portion of this act and applicable law, as it may deem necessary
33 | or convenient in and about the transaction of its business and
34 | in carrying out ~~the provisions of~~ this act.

35 | Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
