12 United States flag or official flag of the State of Florida in a
13 respectful manner, and one portable, removable official flag, in
14 a respectful manner, not larger than 4 1/2 feet by 6 feet, which
15 represents any state, as defined in s. 624.08, or the United
16 States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard, or a

17 POW-MIA flag, regardless of any covenants, restrictions, bylaws,
18 rules, or requirements of the association.

19 (b) Any homeowner may erect a freestanding flagpole no
20 more than 20 feet high on any portion of the homeowner's real
21 property, regardless of any covenants, restrictions, bylaws,
22 rules, or requirements of the association, if the flagpole does
23 not obstruct sightlines at intersections and is not erected
24 within or upon an easement. The homeowner may further display in
25 a respectful manner from that flagpole, regardless of any
26 covenants, restrictions, bylaws, rules, or requirements of the
27 association, one official United States flag, not larger than 4
28 1/2 feet by 6 feet, and may additionally display one official
29 flag of the State of Florida, any state, as defined in s.
30 624.08, or the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or
31 Coast Guard, or a POW-MIA flag. Such additional flag must be
32 equal in size to or smaller than the United States flag. The
33 flagpole and display are subject to all building codes, zoning
34 setbacks, and other applicable governmental regulations,
35 including, but not limited to, noise and lighting ordinances in
36 the county or municipality in which the flagpole is erected and
37 all setback and locational criteria contained in the governing
38 documents.
