19 Any homeowner may erect a freestanding flagpole no (b) 20 more than 20 feet high on any portion of the homeowner's real 21 property, regardless of any covenants, restrictions, bylaws, 22 rules, or requirements of the association, if the flagpole does 23 not obstruct sightlines at intersections and is not erected 24 within or upon an easement.
