28	(c) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May; or
29	(d) Independence Day, July 4.
30	(2) This chapter does not prohibit the offer for sale,
31	sale, purchase, or use of fireworks that are to be used or used
32	solely and exclusively during a designated holiday.
33	(3) Any person who purchases fireworks must be 18 years of
34	age or older.
35	(4) A retailer or seasonal retailer charged with
36	unlawfully selling fireworks to a person under 18 years of age
37	has a complete defense if, at the time the fireworks were sold,
38	the retailer, seasonal retailer, or an employee or agent of the
39	retailer or seasonal retailer carefully checked a driver license
10	or an identification card issued by this state or another state
11	of the United States, a passport, or a United States Armed
12	Services identification card presented by the buyer, and acted
13	in good faith and in reliance upon the representation and
