An act relating to arrests; amending s. 901.15, F.S.; authorizing warrantless arrests when a law enforcement

officer has probable cause to believe that a minor has violated s. 790.22, F.S.; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (17) is added to section 901.15, Florida Statutes, to read:

901.15 When arrest by officer without warrant is lawful.—A law enforcement officer may arrest a person without a warrant when:

(17) There is probable cause to believe that the person is a minor who has committed a criminal act in violation of s. 790.22(3).

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
