2           An act relating to a special election; providing for a  
3           special election to be held August 18, 2020, pursuant  
4           to Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution,  
5           for the approval or rejection by the electors of this  
6           state of amendments to the State Constitution,  
7           proposed by joint resolution, to increase from 2 years  
8           to 3 years, the period of time during which accrued  
9           Save-Our-Homes benefits may be transferred from a  
10          prior homestead to a new homestead, and to provide an  
11          effective date if such amendments are adopted;  
12          providing for publication of notice and for  
13          procedures; providing a contingent effective date.

15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

17           Section 1. Pursuant to Section 5 of Article XI of the  
18 State Constitution, there shall be a special election on  
19 Tuesday, August 18, 2020, to be held concurrently with other  
20 statewide elections held on that date, if any, at which there  
21 shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or  
22 rejection the amendments to the State Constitution proposed in  
23 House Joint Resolution 369, 2020 Regular Session, or a similar  
24 joint resolution having substantially the same specific intent  
25 and purpose.

26           Section 2. Publication of notice shall be in accordance  
27 with Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution. The  
28 special election shall be held as other special elections are  
29 held.

30           Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law,  
31 if enacted by a vote of at least three-fourths of the membership  
32 of each house of the Legislature and if House Joint Resolution  
33 369, 2020 Regular Session, or a similar joint resolution having  
34 substantially the same specific intent and purpose, is adopted  
35 by both houses of the Legislature.
