> 379.2426 RegulationPossession of separated shark fins on the water prohibited; penalties.-

- (1) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "Land" means the physical act of bringing a harvested organism, or any part thereof, ashore.
 - (b) "Shark" means any species of the orders



11	Carcharhiniformes, Lamniformes, Hexanchiformes,	
12	Orectolobiformes, Pristiophoriformes, Squaliformes,	
13	Squatiniformes, or any part thereof.	
14	(c) "Shark fin" means the detached fin of a shark,	
15	including the caudal or tail fin, or any portion thereof.	
16	(d) "Separated," with respect to a shark fin, means not	
17	naturally attached to the corresponding shark body through some	
18	portion of uncut skin.	
19	(2) A person may not possess in or on the waters of this	
20	state a shark fin that has been separated from a shark or land a	
21	separated shark fin in this state, unless:	
22	(a) Such possession is authorized by commission rule; or	
23	(b) Such fin has been lawfully obtained on land, prepared	
24	by taxidermy, and is possessed for the purposes of display.	
25	(3) The import to and export from this state of shark fins	
26	is prohibited.
