The homeowner may further display in a respectful manner from that flagpole, regardless of any 23 covenants, restrictions, bylaws, rules, or requirements of the 24 25 association, one official United States flag, not larger than 4 1/2 feet by 6 feet, and may additionally display one official 26 27 flag of the State of Florida, any state, as defined in s. 624.08, or the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or 28 29 Coast Guard, or a POW-MIA flag. Such additional flag must be 30 equal in size to or smaller than the United States flag. The flagpole and display are subject to all building codes, zoning 31 32 setbacks, and other applicable governmental regulations, 33 including, but not limited to, noise and lighting ordinances in 34 the county or municipality in which the flagpole is erected and 35 all setback and locational criteria contained in the governing 36 documents.
