Section 3. Section 985.031, Florida Statutes, is created to
read:

985.031 Age limitation; exception.—

(1) This section may be cited as the "Kaia Rolle Act."

(2) A child younger than 7 years of age may not be
adjudicated delinquent, arrested, or charged with a violation of
law or a delinquent act on the basis of acts occurring before he

12 or she reaches 7 years of age.

13 (3) Notwithstanding this section, a child who commits a
14 forcible felony as defined in s. 776.08 may be adjudicated
