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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to fees; amending s. 381.06017, F.S.,
as created by SB 512; requiring certain nonembryonic
stem cell banks to pay specified fees; providing a
contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (i) is added to subsection (2) of
section 381.06017, Florida Statutes, as created by SB 512, to
read:

381.06017 Nonembryonic stem cell banks; collection,
manufacturing, storage, dispensing, and use of human
nonembryonic stem cells.—

(2) DUTIES AND REGISTRATION.—A nonembryonic stem cell bank
that advertises, collects, stores, manufactures, dispenses,
compounds, uses, or purports to use nonembryonic stem cells or
products containing nonembryonic stem cells is deemed a clinic
as defined in s. 400.9905 and must comply with all of the
following requirements:

(i) Pay all fees associated with health care clinic
licensure, registration, and inspection under part X of chapter
400 and part II of chapter 408.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date that
SB 512 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation
is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension
thereof and becomes a law.
