13 <u>a.l.</u> Major violations include, but are not limited to, 14 knowingly allowing an ineligible student to participate in a 15 contest representing a member school in an interscholastic 16 contest or committing a violation of the FHSAA's recruiting or 17 sportsmanship policies.

18 b.2. Sanctions placed upon an individual coach may include, but are not limited to, prohibiting or suspending the 19 20 coach from coaching, participating in, or attending any athletic activity sponsored, recognized, or sanctioned by the FHSAA and 21 the member school for which the coach committed the violation. 22 23 If a coach is sanctioned by the FHSAA and the coach transfers to 24 another member school, those sanctions remain in full force and 25 effect during the term of the sanction.

26 <u>c.3.</u> If a member school is assessed a financial penalty as 27 a result of a coach committing a major violation, the coach 28 shall reimburse the member school before being allowed to coach, 29 participate in, or attend any athletic activity sponsored, 30 recognized, or sanctioned by the FHSAA and a member school.

31 <u>d.4.</u> The FHSAA shall establish a due process procedure for 32 coaches sanctioned under this paragraph, consistent with the 33 appeals procedures set forth in subsection (7).

34 <u>2. Require the governing boards of member schools to</u> 35 <u>approve the employment or continued employment of individuals</u> 36 <u>who have a felony conviction.</u>
