Remove lines 1019-1022 of the amendment and insert:

Section 13. Paragraph (f) of subsection (2) of section 1006.20, Florida Statutes, is amended, and paragraph (n) is added to that subsection, to read:

1006.20 Athletics in public K-12 schools.—

(2) ADOPTION OF BYLAWS, POLICIES, OR GUIDELINES.—

(f) The FHSAA shall adopt bylaws that:

1. Establish sanctions for coaches who have committed major violations of the FHSAA's bylaws and policies.

14 knowingly allowing an ineligible student to participate in a
15 contest representing a member school in an interscholastic
16 contest or committing a violation of the FHSAA's recruiting or
17 sportsmanship policies.

18 ~~b.2.~~ Sanctions placed upon an individual coach may
19 include, but are not limited to, prohibiting or suspending the
20 coach from coaching, participating in, or attending any athletic
21 activity sponsored, recognized, or sanctioned by the FHSAA and
22 the member school for which the coach committed the violation.
23 If a coach is sanctioned by the FHSAA and the coach transfers to
24 another member school, those sanctions remain in full force and
25 effect during the term of the sanction.

26 ~~c.3.~~ If a member school is assessed a financial penalty as
27 a result of a coach committing a major violation, the coach
28 shall reimburse the member school before being allowed to coach,
29 participate in, or attend any athletic activity sponsored,
30 recognized, or sanctioned by the FHSAA and a member school.

31 ~~d.4.~~ The FHSAA shall establish a due process procedure for
32 coaches sanctioned under this paragraph, consistent with the
33 appeals procedures set forth in subsection (7).

35 approve the employment or continued employment of individuals
36 who have a felony conviction.
