Between lines 1257 and 1258, insert:

Section 16. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) and subsection (3) of section 1002.391, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

1002.391 Auditory-oral education programs.—

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(a) "Auditory-oral education program" means a program that develops and relies solely on listening skills and uses an implant or assistive hearing device for the purpose of relying on speech and spoken language skills as the method of communication and uses faculty and supervisors certified as

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14 listening and spoken language specialists each day the child is
15 in attendance.

16 (3) The level of services shall be determined by the
17 individual educational plan team or individualized family
18 support plan team, which includes the child's parent in
19 accordance with the rules of the State Board of Education and a
20 certified listening and spoken language specialist from the
21 family's chosen program. A child is eligible for services under
22 this section until the end of the school year in which he or she
23 reaches the age of 7 years or after grade 2, whichever comes
24 first.
