 9 information, or surveillance techniques, procedures, or
 10 personnel, or any other information held by a law enforcement
 11 agency which is exempt or confidential and exempt, is discussed
 12 are exempt from s. 286.011 and s. 24(b), Art. I of the State
 13 Constitution.

14 (b) All exempt portions of such meetings must be recorded
 15 and transcribed. These recordings and transcripts are
 16 confidential and exempt from disclosure under s. 119.07(1) and

17 s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution, unless a court of
18 competent jurisdiction determines, after an in-camera review of
19 such recordings and transcripts, that the meeting was not
20 restricted to the discussion of the information that was made
21 exempt or confidential and exempt by this section. If the court
22 makes that determination, only the portion of the recording or
23 transcript that reveals nonexempt data and information may be
24 disclosed to a third party.
