12 (4) (a) Any portion of a meeting that would reveal building
 13 plans, blueprints, schematic drawings, or diagrams, including
 14 draft, preliminary, and final formats, which depict the
 15 structural elements of 911 or E911 communication system
 16 infrastructure, including towers, antennae, equipment or

17 facilities used to provide 911 or E911 communication services,
18 or other 911 and E911 communication structures or facilities
19 made exempt by s. 119.071(3)(e)1.a. is exempt from s. 286.011
20 and s. 24, Art. I of the State Constitution.

21 (b) Any portion of a meeting that would reveal
22 geographical maps indicating the actual or proposed locations of
23 911 or E911 communication system infrastructure, including
24 towers, antennae, equipment or facilities used to provide 911 or
25 E911 communication services, or other 911 or E911 communication
26 structures or facilities made exempt by s. 119.071(3)(e)1.b. is
27 exempt from s. 286.011 and s. 24, Art. I of the State
28 Constitution.

29 (c) No portion of an exempt meeting under paragraphs (a)
30 or (b) may be off the record. All exempt portions of such
31 meeting shall be recorded and transcribed. Such recordings and
32 transcripts are confidential and exempt from disclosure under s.
33 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution unless
34 a court of competent jurisdiction, after an in-camera review,
35 determines that the meeting was not restricted to the discussion
36 of the information made exempt by s. 119.071(3)(e)1.a or b. In
37 the event of such a judicial determination, only that portion of
38 the recording and transcript which reveals nonexempt information
39 may be disclosed to a third party.
