23	county and governmental entities therein or additional multi-
24	county governmental entities. In addition to any requirements in
25	subsection (3), a registration is incomplete until the
26	commission receives the lobbyist's registration fee.
27	(b) A governmental entity may not charge a fee for the
28	registration of lobbyists and principals, or for the enforcement
29	of lobbyist regulation except as may be reasonable and necessary

30	to cover the cost of such enforcement. A governmental entity may
31	not charge a fee for enforcement upon initial registration. Such
32	fees may only be charged in the event that an enforcement action

35	Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date that
36	SB or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation
37	is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension
38	thereof and becomes a law.
