1 2 An act relating to driver licenses and identification 3 cards; amending s. 322.08, F.S.; requiring application 4 forms for original, renewal, and replacement driver 5 licenses and identification cards to include language 6 allowing a voluntary contribution to the Live Like 7 Bella Childhood Cancer Foundation; amending s. 322.14, 8 F.S.; authorizing a person with specified disabilities 9 to have the capital letter "D" placed on his or her 10 driver license under certain circumstances; providing requirements for the placement of such letter on, or 11 12 the removal of such letter from, a person's driver 13 license; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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- Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 322.08, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 322.08 Application for license; requirements for license and identification card forms.—
  - (8) The application form for an original, renewal, or replacement driver license or identification card must include language permitting the following:
  - (a) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which contribution shall be deposited into the Health Care Trust Fund

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for organ and tissue donor education and for maintaining the organ and tissue donor registry.

- (b) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the Florida Council of the Blind.
- (c) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the Hearing Research Institute, Incorporated.
- (d) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation International.
- (e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the Children's Hearing Help Fund.
- (f) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to Family First, a nonprofit organization.
- (g) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Stop Heart Disease, which shall be distributed to the Florida Heart Research Institute, a nonprofit organization.
- (h) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Senior Vision Services, which shall be distributed to the Florida Association of Agencies Serving the Blind, Inc., a not-forprofit organization.
- (i) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for services for persons with developmental disabilities, which shall be distributed to The Arc of Florida.
  - (j) A voluntary contribution of \$1 to the Ronald McDonald

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- House, which shall be distributed each month to Ronald McDonald House Charities of Tampa Bay, Inc.
- (k) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the League Against Cancer/La Liga Contra el Cancer, a not-for-profit organization.
- (1) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Prevent Child Sexual Abuse, which shall be distributed to Lauren's Kids, Inc., a nonprofit organization.
- (m) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-for-profit organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight of the residents of this state.
- (n) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the state homes for veterans, to be distributed on a quarterly basis by the department to the Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund within the Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- (o) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, which shall be distributed quarterly to Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, a nonprofit organization.
- (p) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for Autism Services and Supports, which shall be distributed to Achievement and Rehabilitation Centers, Inc., Autism Services

- (q) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Support Our Troops, which shall be distributed to Support Our Troops, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.
- (r) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to aid the homeless. Contributions made pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund of the Department of Children and Families and used by the State Office on Homelessness to supplement grants made under s. 420.622(4) and (5), provide information to the public about homelessness in the state, and provide literature for homeless persons seeking assistance.
- (s) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant to End Breast Cancer, which shall be distributed to the Florida Breast Cancer Foundation.
- (t) Notwithstanding s. 322.081(1), a voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant to Childhood Cancer Care, which shall be distributed to the Live Like Bella Childhood Cancer Foundation.

A statement providing an explanation of the purpose of the trust funds shall also be included. For the purpose of applying the service charge provided under s. 215.20, contributions received under paragraphs  $\underline{(b)-(t)}$   $\underline{(b)-(s)}$  are not income of a revenue nature.

Upon request by a person who has a developmental 106 disability, or by a parent or legal guardian of a child or ward 107 who has a developmental disability, the capital letter "D" shall 108 be exhibited on the driver license of a person who has a 109 developmental disability, as defined in s. 393.063, if the 110 person, or his or her parent or legal guardian, presents 111 sufficient proof that the person has been diagnosed with a 112 developmental disability by a physician licensed under chapter 113 458 or chapter 459 as determined by the department. 114 2. Until a person's driver license is next renewed, the 115 person, or his or her parent or legal quardian, may have the capital letter "D" added to or removed from his or her license 116 117 upon the surrender of his or her current license and 118 presentation of sufficient proof that the person has been 119 diagnosed with a developmental disability by a physician 120 licensed under chapter 458 or chapter 459 as determined by the department. If the applicant is not conducting any other 121 122 transaction affecting the driver license, a replacement license may be issued with the capital letter "D" added or removed 123 124 without payment of the fee required in s. 322.21(1)(e). 125 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2020.

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
