A bill to be entitled

An act relating to statewide active shooter response planning; creating s. 943.688, F.S.; requiring the Department of Law Enforcement, in consultation with law enforcement agencies throughout the state, to establish a uniform statewide rule on preparing for and responding to active shooters; providing minimum rule requirements; requiring each law enforcement agency to adopt an active shooter policy or rule, as appropriate, by a specified date; requiring the department to adopt rules; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 943.688, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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943.688 Statewide active shooter response planning.-

(1) The department, in consultation with law enforcement

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agencies throughout the state and considering the unique needs
of different geographic regions where those agencies are

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located, shall establish a uniform statewide rule on minimum standards and requirements for how each law enforcement agency in the state must prepare and respond to active shooter

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situations within their jurisdictions. At a minimum, the uniform statewide rule must address all of the following:

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(a) Detailed procedures for how to respond to a report of an alleged active shooter.

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(b) Detailed procedures for how communications and

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notifications will be handled with all affected parties and the media.

- (c) Detailed procedures for who from the appropriate law enforcement agency will respond and how they will do so. This includes having a designated person and an alternate person who have been trained or certified on how to handle active shooter situations.
- (d) Primary and alternate routes to potential targets within each law enforcement agency's jurisdiction.
- (2) Each law enforcement agency in this state shall enact a policy or rule, as appropriate, on active shooter preparedness and response by no later than January 1, 2021. The policy or rule enacted must, at a minimum, include the uniform statewide rule that the department adopts under subsection (1).
- $\underline{\mbox{(3)}}$ The department shall adopt rules to administer this section.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
