14	local significance in the history of civil rights and to				
15	highlight the achievements of local African-American				
16	communities, and				
17	WHEREAS, in August 2002, the park was added to the National				
18	Register of Historic Places; in 2006, it was added to the State				
19	of Florida Heritage Trail; and in February 2008, it reopened to				
20	the public as the Historic Virginia Key Beach Park, and				
21	WHEREAS, in 2010, the Historic Virginia Key Beach Park was				
22	included as a major stakeholder in the Virginia Key Master Plan,				
23	which had been approved by the City of Miami City Commission in				
24	2006, a turning point in the life of the park, and
