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 11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 13           Section 1. Subsections (6) through (10) of section  
 14           397.334, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (7)  
 15           through (11), respectively, and a new subsection (6) is added to  
 16           that section, to read:

17           397.334 Treatment-based drug court programs.—

18           (6) If the court orders a defendant to enter into a  
 19           pretrial treatment-based drug court program or a  
 20           postadjudicatory treatment-based drug court program, and if the  
 21           defendant is ordered to document participation in self-help or  
 22           other support groups and activities as an element of ancillary  
 23           services, as described in s. 394.67, the court may offer the  
 24           defendant an option for either electronic or written  
 25           verification of such participation.

26 Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 397.403, Florida  
27 Statutes, is amended to read:

28 397.403 License application.—

29 (3) Applications for licensure renewal must include proof  
30 of application for accreditation for each licensed service  
31 component providing clinical treatment by an accrediting  
32 organization that is acceptable to the department for the first  
33 renewal, and proof of accreditation for any subsequent renewals.  
34 This subsection does not apply to any offender ~~inmate~~ substance  
35 abuse program operated by or under an exclusive contract with a  
36 jail or the Department of Corrections.

37 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
