

1 A bill to be entitled
2 An act relating to lottery games; amending s. 24.105,
3 F.S.; prohibiting an electronic device from being used
4 by a player to play any lottery game; prohibiting the
5 department from authorizing the operation of a
6 specified lottery game; amending s. 24.107, F.S.;
7 requiring the Department of the Lottery to include a
8 specified warning in all advertisements and promotions
9 of lottery games; providing exceptions; providing
10 requirements for such warning; amending s. 24.111,
11 F.S.; requiring all contracts between the department
12 and a vendor to include a provision that requires the
13 vendor to place or print a specified warning on all
14 lottery tickets; providing an exception; providing
15 requirements for such warning; providing an effective
16 date.

18 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

20 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (9) of section
21 24.105, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

22 24.105 Powers and duties of department.—The department
23 shall:

24 (9) Adopt rules governing the establishment and operation
25 of the state lottery, including:

26 (a) The type of lottery games to be conducted, except
 27 that:

28 1. The ~~No~~ name of an elected official may not ~~shall~~ appear
 29 on the ticket or play slip of any lottery game or on any prize
 30 or on any instrument used for the payment of prizes, unless such
 31 prize is in the form of a state warrant.

32 2. ~~No~~ Coins or currency may not ~~shall~~ be dispensed from
 33 any electronic computer terminal or electronic device used in
 34 any lottery game.

35 3. Other than as specifically provided in s. 24.112, an
 36 electronic computer ~~no~~ terminal or electronic device may not be
 37 used by the player to play for any lottery game ~~which may be~~
 38 ~~operated solely by the player without the assistance of the~~
 39 ~~retailer.~~

40 4. The department may not authorize the operation of a
 41 lottery game in which the winner is chosen on the basis of the
 42 activities or outcomes of one or more sporting events.

43 Section 2. Subsection (3) is added to section 24.107,
 44 Florida Statutes, to read:

45 24.107 Advertising and promotion of lottery games.—

46 (3) Beginning January 1, 2021, all advertisements and
 47 promotions of lottery games under this chapter, excluding multi-
 48 state lottery games, must include a warning that meets all of
 49 the following requirements:

50 (a) If on television, on the Internet, or in any other

51 electronic medium, appear in black font on a white background
 52 and occupy at least 5 percent of the total surface area of the
 53 advertisement or promotion.

54 (b) If in print, including in a newspaper, in a magazine,
 55 or on a billboard, appear in prominent text and occupy at least
 56 5 percent of the total surface area of the advertisement or
 57 promotion.

58 (c) If on radio, be audibly announced at the conclusion of
 59 the advertisement or promotion.

60 (d) Contain the following message: "PLAY RESPONSIBLY."

 62 This subsection does not apply to advertisements and promotions
 63 on vending machines authorized under s. 24.112(15) or equipment
 64 used by a retailer.

65 Section 3. Subsection (8) is added to section 24.111,
 66 Florida Statutes, to read:

67 24.111 Vendors; disclosure and contract requirements.—

68 (8) Beginning January 1, 2021, all contracts subject to
 69 this section must contain a provision that requires the vendor
 70 to place or print a warning on all lottery tickets sold under
 71 this chapter, excluding multi-state lottery tickets. The warning
 72 must meet all of the following requirements:

73 (a) Appear in prominent text on the front side of the
 74 lottery ticket and occupy at least 5 percent of the total
 75 surface area of the lottery ticket.
