(b), but not later than 1 year after the hearing, the local government may proceed to take those measures necessary to provide the service. The  $\frac{A}{A}$  local government shall provide 3 years' notice to the a private company before it engages in the actual provision of the service that displaces the company. At the end of the 3-year notice period As an alternative to delaying displacement 3 years, the a local government shall may pay the a displaced company an amount equal to the company's preceding 18 15 months' gross receipts for the displaced service in the displacement area. The 3-year notice period shall lapse as to any private company being displaced when the company ceases to provide service within the displacement area. Nothing in this paragraph prohibits the local government and the company from voluntarily negotiating a different notice period or amount of compensation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
