(c) The State of Florida has a duty to equitably and fairly enforce its laws, with little to no disparate impact on the members of any specific racial or ethnic group. If the State of Florida or a person authorized by the State of Florida breaches that duty, the state is civilly liable for any damages proximately caused by the breach of duty by the state or the authorized person. This liability is limited to any adverse
