Amendment to Amendment (649221) (with title amendment)

Remove lines 23-39 and insert:

(a) Interscholastic, intercollegiate, intramural, or club athletic teams or sports that are sponsored by a secondary school or postsecondary institution shall be expressly designated as one of the following based on biological sex:

- 1. Males, men, or boys;
- 2. Females, women, or girls; or
- 3. Coed or mixed.

(b) Athletic teams or sports designated for females, women, or girls may not be open to students of the male sex.
