The court may impose a civil 17 penalty of \$1,000 per day for noncompliance with an injunction and shall award reasonable attorney fees and court costs related 18 19 to the issuance and enforcement of the injunction. Moneys 20 recovered for civil penalties under this paragraph section shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund. 21

22 (b) If a person or an entity was required to remove an 23 arrest booking photograph under this section and later 24 republishes or otherwise redisseminates the photograph in the 25 publication or electronic medium, the person whose photograph is 26 republished or redisseminated may bring a civil action to enjoin 27 the continued publication or dissemination of the photograph. 28 The court may impose a civil penalty of \$5,000 per day for 29 noncompliance with an injunction and shall award reasonable 30 attorney fees and court costs related to the issuance and 31 enforcement of the injunction. Moneys recovered for civil 32 penalties under this paragraph shall be deposited into the 33 General Revenue Fund.
