6 Remove lines 40-57 and insert:

7 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public  
8 necessity that information received or maintained by the  
9 Department of Military Affairs and stored in a United States  
10 Department of Defense system of records, transmitted using a  
11 United States Department of Defense network or communications  
12 device, or pertaining to the United States Department of  
13 Defense, pursuant to 10 U.S.C. s. 394, be made exempt from s.  
14 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the  
15 State Constitution. The disclosure of such sensitive military  
16 information within these systems such as information on military

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17 missions, units, personnel, deployments, and troop concentration  
18 could adversely affect military members and national security.  
19 For this reason it is necessary that such sensitive military  
20 information in the custody of the Department of Military Affairs  
21 be protected from disclosure to the same degree that is required  
22 under federal law. Therefore, the Legislature finds that it is a  
23 public necessity that such information be made exempt from  
24 public record requirements.
