7 (4) DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS.—Information received
8 or maintained by the Department of Military Affairs that is
9 stored in a United States Department of Defense system of
10 records, transmitted using a United States Department of Defense
11 network or communications device, or pertaining to the United
12 States Department of Defense, pursuant to 10 U.S.C. §394, is
13 exempt from s. 119.07(1) and section 24(a) of Article I of the
14 State Constitution. Any information not made exempt by this
15 subsection may be disclosed only after the department makes any
16 redactions in accordance with applicable federal and state laws.

17 This exemption applies to information made exempt by this
18 subsection which is held by the department before, on, or after
19 the effective date of the exemption. This subsection is subject
20 to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s.
21 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2026, unless
22 reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the
23 Legislature.

24 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public
25 necessity that certain information received or maintained by the
26 Department of Military Affairs that is stored in a United States
27 Department of Defense system of records, transmitted using a
28 United States Department of Defense network or communications
29 device, or pertaining to the United States Department of
