Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 83 and 84

insert:

Section 3. Paragraph (e) is added to subsection (1) of section 403.928, Florida Statutes, to read:

403.928 Assessment of water resources and conservation lands.—The Office of Economic and Demographic Research shall conduct an annual assessment of Florida's water resources and conservation lands.

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(1) WATER RESOURCES.-The assessment must include all of the

27	(b) "Facility" means any equipment, structure, or other
28	property, including sewerage systems and treatment works, used
29	to provide wastewater services.
30	(c) "Treatment works" has the same meaning as provided in
31	<u>s. 403.031(11).</u>
32	(d) "Wastewater services" means service to a sewerage
33	system, as defined in s. 403.031(9), or service to domestic
34	wastewater treatment works.
