21 the statutory purpose of the special district, provide
22 sufficient direction for the district's programs and activities,
23 and may be achieved within the district's adopted budget.

24 (g) Any performance measures and standards of the special
25 district's programs and activities using data from the current
26 year and the previous 3 fiscal years, including:

27 1. Whether the performance measures and standards are
28 relevant, useful, and sufficient to evaluate the costs of the
29 programs and activities.

34 (h) Factors that have contributed to any failure to meet
35 the special district's performance measures and standards or
36 achieve the district's goals and objectives, including a
37 description of efforts taken by the special district to prevent
38 such failure in the future.

39 (i) Recommendations for statutory or budgetary changes to
40 improve the special district's program operations, reduce costs,
41 or reduce duplication, including the potential benefits to be
42 achieved and the potential adverse consequences of the proposed
43 changes.

44 (2) (a) Each independent special district as described in
45 subparagraph (d)1. that is not located in a rural area of
46 opportunity as defined in s. 288.0656(2) and each independent
47 special district as described in subparagraph (d)2. must
48 contract with an independent entity to conduct a performance
49 review of the district. The independent entity must have at
50 least 5 years of experience conducting comparable reviews of
