4 Between lines 227 and 228, insert:

5 Section 4. Subsection (3) of section 1003.433, Florida
6 Statutes, is amended to read:

7 1003.433 Learning opportunities for out-of-state and out-
8 of-country transfer students and students needing additional
9 instruction to meet high school graduation requirements.-

10 (3) Students who have been enrolled in an ESOL program for
11 less than 2 school years and have met all requirements for the
12 standard high school diploma except for passage of any must-pass

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13 assessment under s. 1003.4282 or s. 1008.22 or alternate
14 assessment may:

15 (a) Receive immersion English language instruction during
16 the summer following their senior year. Students receiving such
17 instruction are eligible to take the required assessment or
18 alternate assessment and receive a standard high school diploma
19 upon passage of the required assessment or alternate assessment.
20 This paragraph subsection shall be implemented to the extent
21 funding is provided in the General Appropriations Act.

22 (b) Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, meet the
23 requirement to pass the statewide, standardized grade 10 English
24 Language Arts assessment by satisfactorily demonstrating grade-
25 level expectations on formative assessments, in accordance with
26 state board rule.
