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7 (2) Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, each public  
8 school shall provide to a parent who initially enrolls his or  
9 her child in the school, information on the important role water  
10 safety education courses and swimming lessons play in saving  
11 lives. The information must be provided electronically or in  
12 hardcopy and must include local options for age-appropriate  
13 water safety courses and swimming lessons that result in a  
14 certificate indicating successful completion, including courses  
15 and lessons offered for free or at a reduced price. If the  
16 student is 18 or older, or is under the age of 21 and is

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17 enrolling in adult education classes, the information must be  
18 provided to the student.
