11 (a) State agencies must provide the Florida Digital

16 (b) The Florida Digital Service must participate in the

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17 development of specifications and recommend modifications to any

19 state agencies so that the procurement complies with the  
20 enterprise architecture.

21 (c) The Florida Digital Service must participate in post-  
22 award contract monitoring.

23 Section 2. Section 287.0591, Florida Statutes, is amended  
24 to read:

25 287.0591 Information technology.—

26 (1) ~~Beginning July 1, 2014,~~ Any competitive solicitation  
27 issued by the department for a state term contract for  
28 information technology commodities must include a term that does  
29 not exceed 48 months.

30 (2) ~~Beginning September 1, 2015,~~ Any competitive  
31 solicitation issued by the department for a state term contract  
32 for information technology consultant services or information  
33 technology staff augmentation contractual services must include  
34 a term that does not exceed 48 months.

35 (3) The department may execute a state term contract for  
36 information technology commodities, consultant services, or  
37 staff augmentation contractual services that exceeds the 48-  
38 month requirement if the Secretary of Management Services and  
39 the state chief information officer certify in writing to the  
40 Executive Office of the Governor that a longer contract term is  
41 in the best interest of the state.

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42 (4) If the department issues a competitive solicitation  
43 for information technology commodities, consultant services, or  
44 staff augmentation contractual services, the Florida Digital  
45 Service within the department shall participate in such  
46 solicitations.

47 (5) If an agency issues a request for quote to purchase  
48 information technology commodities, information technology  
49 consultant services, or information technology staff  
50 augmentation contractual services from the state term contract,  
51 for any contract with 25 approved vendors or fewer, the agency  
52 must issue a request for quote to all vendors approved to  
53 provide such commodity or service. For any contract with more  
54 than 25 approved vendors, the agency must issue a request for  
55 quote to at least 25 of the vendors approved to provide such  
56 commodity or contractual service. Use of a request for quote  
57 does not constitute a decision or intended decision that is  
58 subject to protest under s. 120.57(3).
