Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 766.31, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- 766.31 Administrative law judge awards for birth-related neurological injuries; notice of award.-
- Upon determining that an infant has sustained a birthrelated neurological injury and that obstetrical services were delivered by a participating physician at the birth, the administrative law judge shall make an award providing compensation for the following items relative to such injury:
- (b) 1. Periodic payments of an award to the parents or legal quardians of the infant found to have sustained a birthrelated neurological injury, which award may shall not exceed \$100,000. However, at the discretion of the administrative law
