An act relating to Indian Trail Improvement District, Palm Beach County; amending ch. 2002-330, Laws of Florida, as amended; revising the boundaries of the district; requiring the execution of interlocal agreements; authorizing the district to study the feasibility of an elector-initiated conversion of the district to a municipality; providing a procedure for such study; providing for a referendum; providing for a transition date and permitting continuation of the district; providing effective dates.

WHEREAS, Indian Trail Improvement District is an independent special district located entirely in Palm Beach County, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the district has determined it would be in the best interests of its residents to consider the feasibility of conversion of the district to a municipality, and

WHEREAS, it would be necessary to amend the district's boundaries, requiring the execution of interlocal agreements, in order to proceed with such conversion pursuant to statutory procedures, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the district wishes to implement a procedure to study the feasibility of an elector-

- (b) Authorizing the district to create an incorporation committee with public membership that would hold public hearings to seek input from the community on the review of the feasibility study and in the development of a draft charter.
  - (c) Developing a draft charter of the municipality.
- (d) Upon petition by 10 percent of the registered voters in the district, conducting a referendum of the electorate within the boundaries of the district on the question of district conversion to a municipality.

Section 19. Indian Trail Improvement District
continuation.—The Indian Trail Improvement District, an
independent special district created by a special act of the
Legislature, shall continue as an independent special district
for those lands which are subject to outstanding indebtedness
until such time as the termination of such indebtedness or the
transition date mutually agreed to by the municipality and the
district. Until the transition date:

- (1) The assets, liabilities, and written contracts of the district, including all rights, obligations, duties, and relationships now existing by law or agreement, shall be unaffected and shall remain in full force and effect.
- (2) To the extent such procedures are not inconsistent with this charter, all resolutions and policies of the district shall remain in effect until amended, revised, or terminated.

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Section 3. Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
