(c) Developing a draft charter of the municipality.
Section 19. Indian Trail Improvement District
continuation.—The Indian Trail Improvement District, an
independent special district created by a special act of the
Legislature, shall continue as an independent special district
for those lands which are subject to outstanding indebtedness
until such time as the termination of such indebtedness or the
transition date mutually agreed to by the municipality and the
district. Until the transition date:
(1) The assets, liabilities, and written contracts of the
district, including all rights, obligations, duties, and
relationships now existing by law or agreement, shall be
unaffected and shall remain in full force and effect.
(2) To the extent such procedures are not inconsistent
with this charter, all resolutions and policies of the district
shall remain in effect until amended, revised, or terminated.

This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
